WHAT IS THE PASSOVER?

Passover as a commemoration of their liberation by God from slavery in ancient Egypt and their freedom as a nation under the leadership of Moses.

“No uncircumcised man may eat it...” (Ex 12:48a)

THE THIRD PASSOVER

The first was in Egypt (Ex 12), when the Lord delivered them; the second at Sinai (Num 9), when He had “brought them unto Himself.”

(3) The third is on the other side Jordan under Joshua.

And kept the Passover

There was power in its remembrance. They were to always live remembering that they were a people delivered and remembering God's work of deliverance.

After the Passover

In the same way, we are to be in constant remembrance of our redemption at Calvary and live our lives in the shadow of the cross.

THE LAND

Exodus 3, "a land flowing with milk and honey."
